
RESPONDING TO THREATS IN PUBLIC

Scenario-Based Training

As close to real-world as possible, this force-on-force training is based on actual events; or can be custom-designed to meet the needs and goals of students.





SUDDEN VIOLENCE & DYNAMIC GROUP BEHAVIOR

Course Time:	7 Hours /Average
Student Pool:	Min. of 4, Max of 12 /Course
Course Cost:	\$300 /Student (Avg.)

This course will introduce students to sudden violence and dynamic group behavior, including theory and review of real-world cases.

Following this, students will participate in an interactive environment to practice, demonstrate, and assess student's knowledge and application of the course.



COUNTER-RESPONSE TO EXTREMISTS & ASYMMETRIC TACTICS

Course Time: 12 Hours /Average
Student Pool: Max of 36 /Course
Course Cost: \$450 /Student (Avg.)

This course will serve to familiarize students with the current and emerging guerrilla and asymmetric tactics adopted and used by extremists and others seeking to unlawfully riot, commit violent crimes, and harm others.

This course includes history, theory, and interactive discussion of real-world incidents.



SCENARIO-BASED TRAINING FORCE-ON-FORCE

Course Time:	10 Hours /Average
Student Pool:	Min. of 6 /Course
Course Cost:	\$550 /Student (Avg.)

The force-on-force scenario-based training is as close to real-life as one can get. This customized training may be based on a real-life event that occurred, or based on the specific needs of those in attendance.

This course can be tailored to fit the needs of first responders, armed professionals, law enforcement, and defense/security practitioners.



INTRODUCTION TO CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON

Course Time:	4 Hours /Average
Student Pool:	Max of 8 /Course
Course Cost:	\$125 /Student (Avg.)

This course is designed for students who are new to, or, who are considering carrying a concealed weapon (pistol) for self-defense. The classroom portion of the course includes an overview of laws and duties, implications and obligations, theory, best practices, and more.

The hands-on portion will allow students to handle a variety of popular handguns, experiment with a wide variety of holsters, and learn about proper concealment and related considerations.



HANDGUN/PISTOL TRAINING

(All levels of instruction)

Course Time:	7 Hours /Average
Student Pool:	Max of 14 /Course
Course Cost:	\$195 /Student (Avg.)

From introduction to concealed carry to advanced combat handgun for armed professionals, a wide range of handgun training courses are available for students no matter what level of experience a student may have.

One-on-one training is offered, as well as niche and specialty courses for individuals or group training.



CARBINE/RIFLE TRAINING

(All levels of instruction)

Course Time:	9 Hours /Average
Student Pool:	Max of 14 /Course
Course Cost:	\$295 /Student (Avg.)

From introduction to modern sporting rifles to advanced patrol carbine courses for armed professionals, a wide range of rifle and carbine training courses are available for students no matter what level of experience a student may have.

One-on-one training is offered, as well as niche and specialty courses for individuals or group training - including AR-15 Armorer.



DISTANCE SHOOTING & DESIGNATED MARKSMAN

Course Time: 10 Hours /Average
Student Pool: Max of 8 /Course
Course Cost: \$550 /Student (Avg.)

This advanced course is intended for students who are already experienced and familiar with the concepts and applications of long-distance shooting and marksmanship; and who are looking to take their skills and abilities to the next level.

One-on-one training is offered, as well as specialty and skill-specific courses for individuals, professionals, and/or group training.



TAC MED / TACTICAL TRAUMA CARE TRAINING

Course Time:	6 Hours /Average
Student Pool:	Min. of 12 /Course
Course Cost:	\$250 /Student (Avg.)

Taught by licensed medical practitioners, this course is far beyond a basic first aid training class. Students will gain the skills to mitigate the most serious injuries which are immediately life-threatening; to include gunshot wounds and stab wounds.

Active student participation is a requirement of this course, and additional modules are available upon request (e.g. AED/CPR, Opiate Overdose, BBP, BLS, and similar).

Course Cost: \$120-750 /Student (Var.)
